Another piece of good news that was just announced is the decision to keep permit prices unchanged from last year. That means that a Full Season Permit will be \$200 if purchased on or before December 1, 2011 (\$250 if purchased after Dec 1, 2011). So get your permit early.

In addition to the price freeze on permits, Riverside Snowmobile Club was one of 2 clubs in the District that saw an increase in Full Season and Classic Permits sales last year. And we are committed to seeing that trend continue by ensuring we have the best trail network in the province.

Trail Report- Gerry Gurnhill

We have an ambitious works program scheduled for this fall and we will need a dynamic group of enthusiastic volunteers if we hope to be ready for the first snowfall. Our plans include the replacement/repair of 4 bridges and the installation of a number of culverts which will help us prevent the problems we encountered in years past with all the water. In addition we have a number of destination signs that need to be installed. These are the large signs you see each year with the trail map and directional arrows. And last, but of critical importance is the yearly installation of the trail signage which is mandatory before any trails can be opened. As permit buyers we all want early open trails and with our second groomer, early trail prep work and signage work completed we could be riding first on Riverside's trail system. 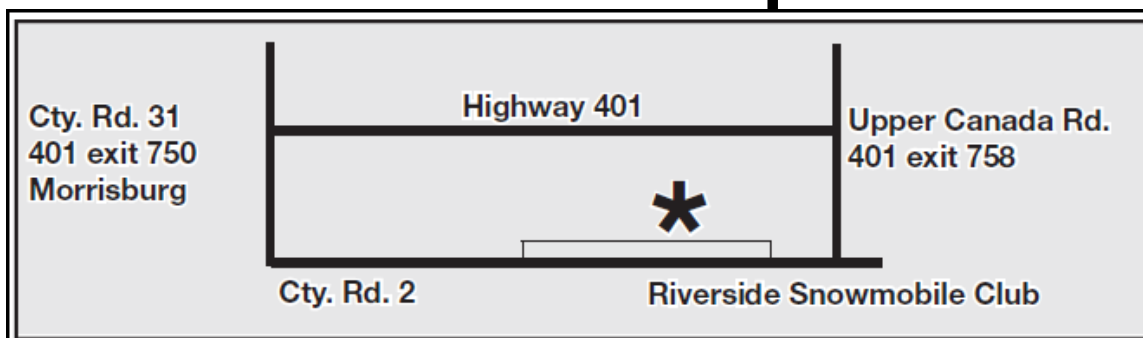
