Welcome to the 2013-2014 snowmobile season. Consider this your personal invitation to purchase your 2013-2014 permit and enjoy over 30,000 km of OFSC trails. By purchasing your permit, you will have the most fun you can have in winter, with all trails leading to our warm and friendly club house.

Last season we saw both our groomers provide us



with excellent trail conditions. Congrats goes out to Gerry and Tom, our operators, for ensuring we had some of the best groomed trails in

Eastern Ontario. In total Gerry and Tom logged over 450 hours grooming Riverside trails last season.

For the 2013-2014 Season, the OFSC membership approved an exciting new program for Trail Permits this season. The attached flyer has all the details, but the highlight is the introduction of a \$180.00 Full Season Permit if purchased online on or before November 1, 2013 and \$210 if purchased on or before Dec 1, 2013. In addition, the price of the Full Season permit purchased after Dec 1st was rolled back from \$280 to \$260. Classic Permits now have a 2-Tier price structure, \$140 On or Before Dec 1. \$170 After Dec 1.

We are also very pleased to announce that Valerie Flay and Les Johnston have achieved their

We have an ambitious works program scheduled for this fall and we will need enthusiastic volunteers if we hope to be ready for the first snowfall. Our plans include the replacement/repair of some bridges and brush cutting on a number of trails. We have also received permission from the South Nation Conservation Authority for a reroute of RS16 near Newington. This reroute will eliminate most of the road running in the Newington area. And of critical importance is the yearly installation of the trail signage which is mandatory before any trails can be opened. As permit buyers we all want early open trails and with your help we can be ready for that first snowfall. 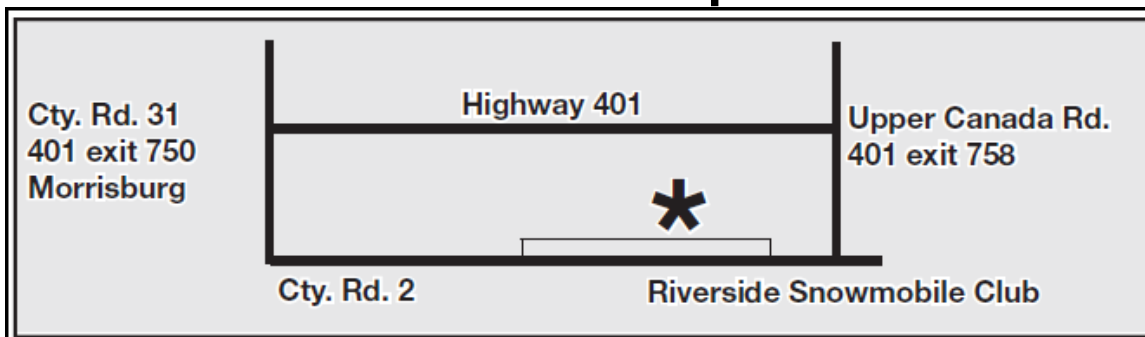
